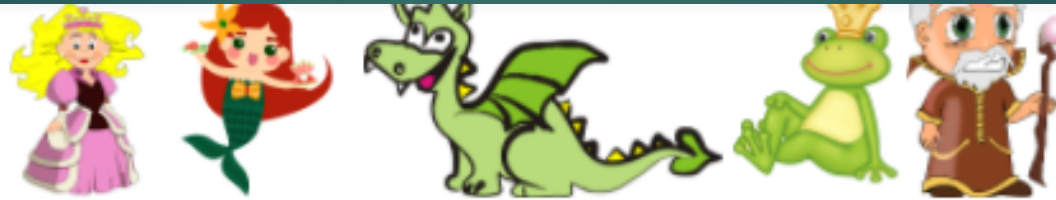

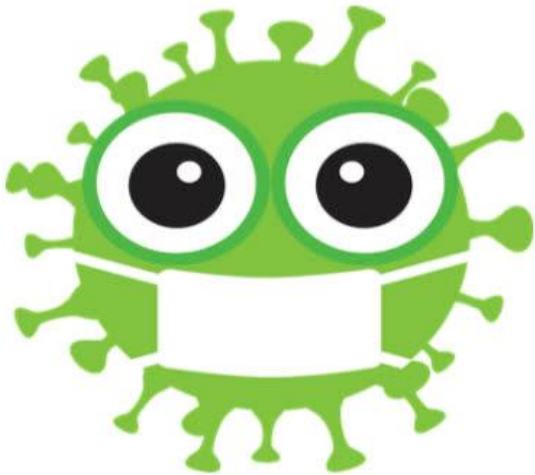

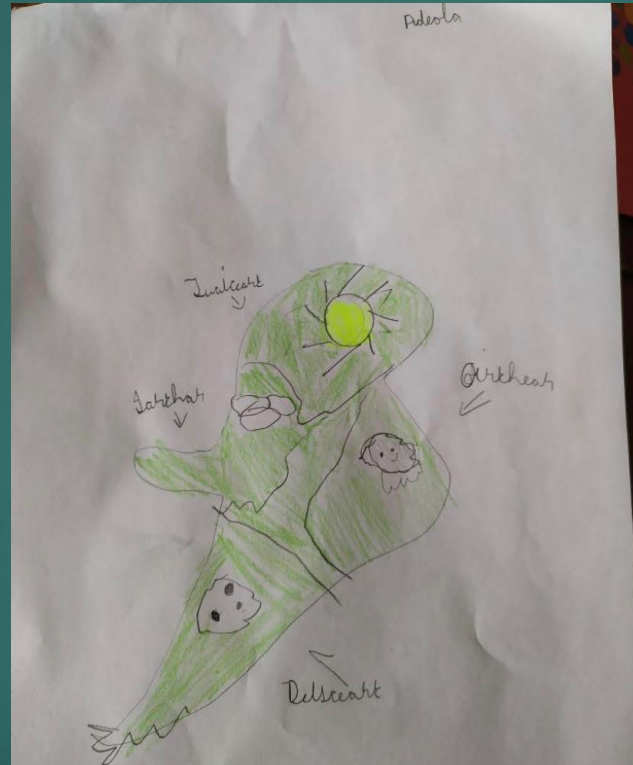

My Free Writing: The Funniest Zoo Animal

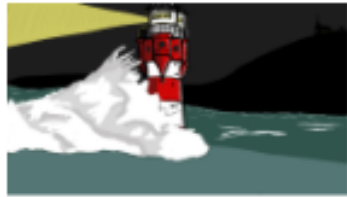

There was a man who lived in a Lighthouse.

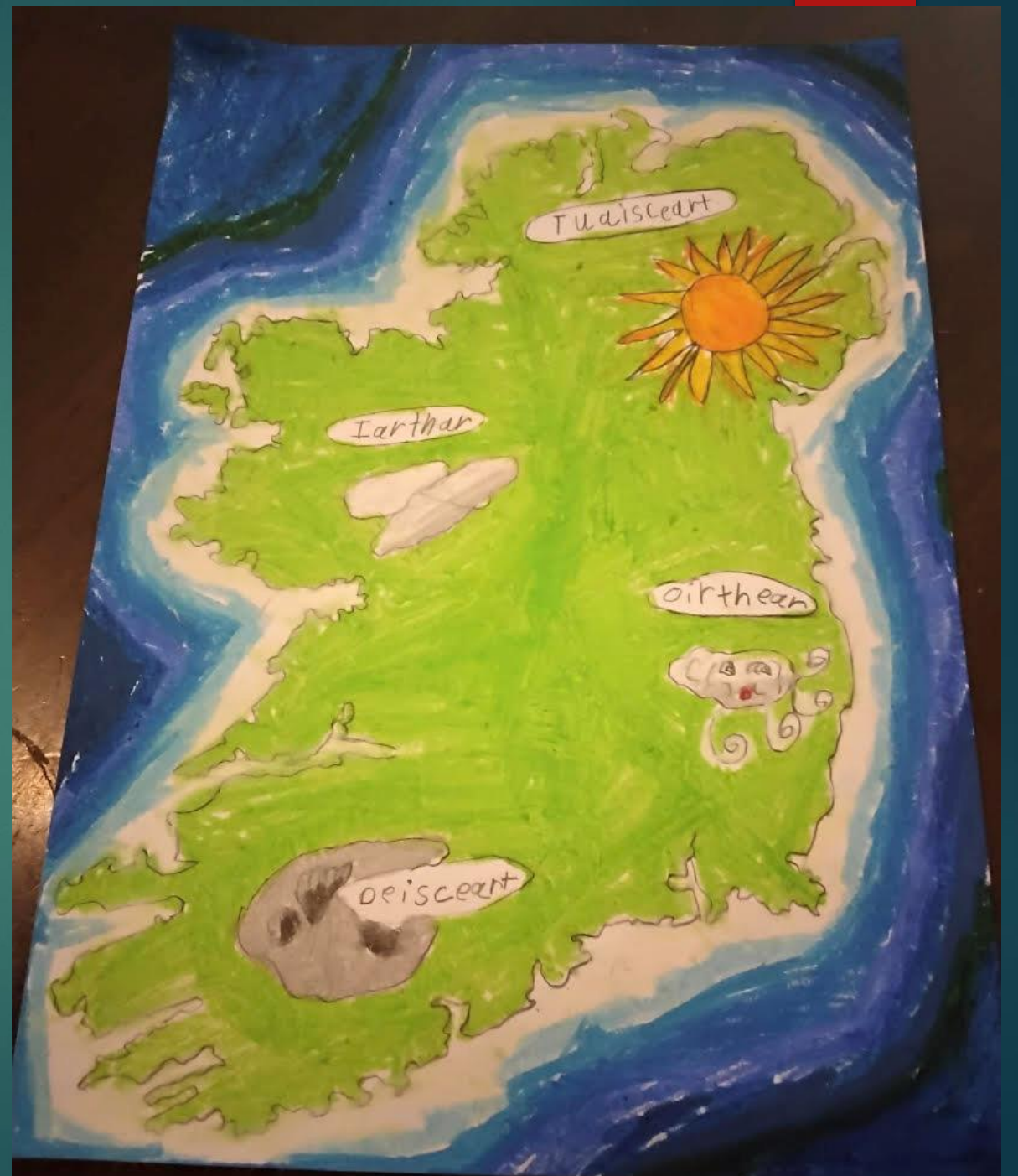
He was writing, then



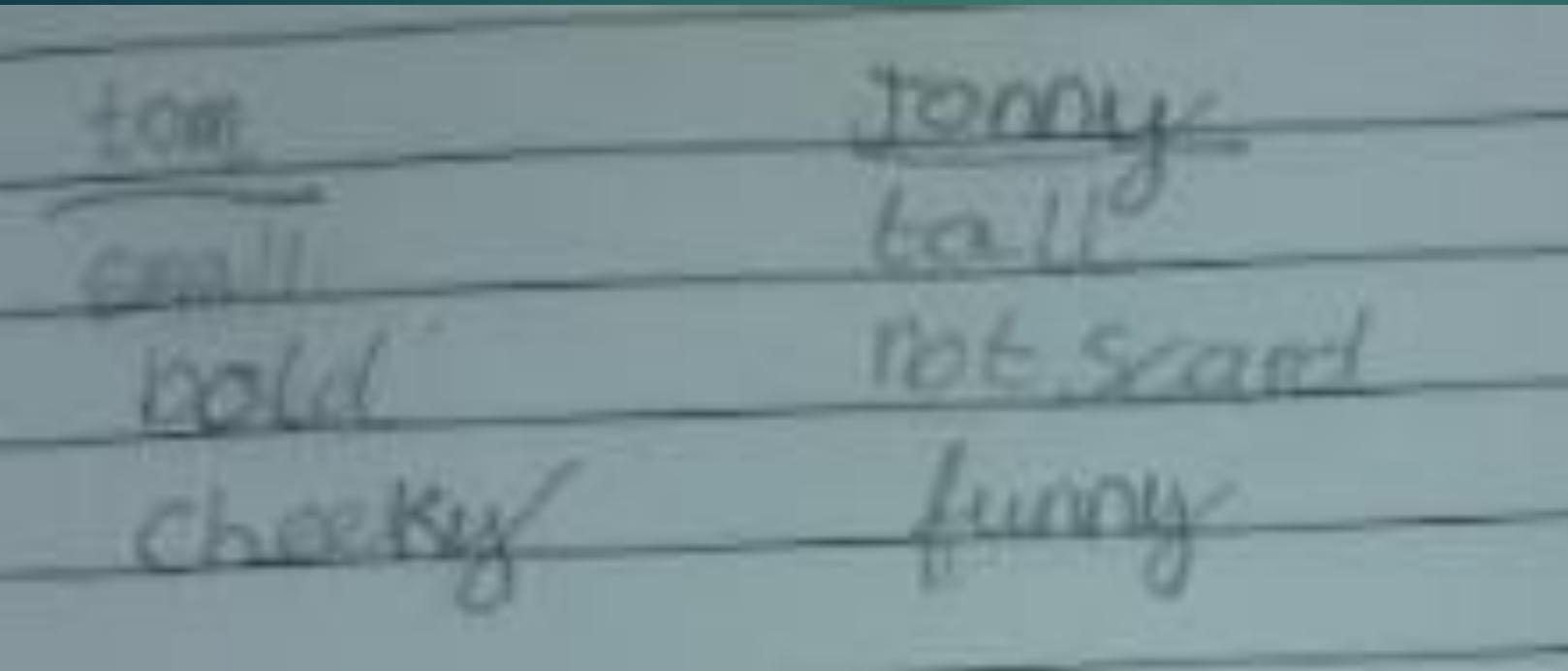
